Shoppes at Venetian

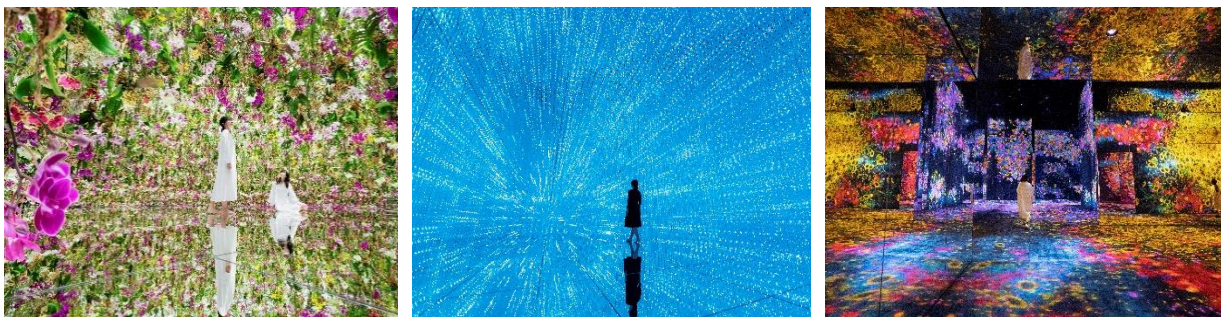

Located at The Venetian® Macao's Cotai Expo, teamLab SuperNature Macao is an extremely complex, three-dimensional interactive space with varying elevations that spans over 5,000 square metres and is comprised of enormous 8-metre-tall works by art collective teamLab. A 'body immersive' art space centred around a group of artworks, it explores new perceptions of the world and the continuity between humans and nature.
